Currently, 46.3% of the 55,772 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 39.2%, renter occupied; and 14.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 53,803 housing units in the area - 51.3% owner occupied, 35.0% renter occupied, and 13.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.61%. Median home value in the area is \$99,609, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 5.34% annually to \$129,227.
